TOPDIVE OPEN WATER DIVER, PADI Level 1 in 4 days

Validity : from January 01st, 2017 to December 31st, 2017

3 main phases :

- > Knowledge Development (E-learning at home before arrival OR in dive center classroom)
- > 2 Confined Water Dives (done in the lagoon) to learn basic scuba skills
- > 4 Open Water Dives (in ocean) to review your skills and explore!

TOPDIVE ADVANCED OPEN WATER DIVER, PADI Level 2 in 2 days

Validity : from January 01st, 2017 to December 31st, 2017

The Advanced Open Water Diver course helps you increase your confidence and build your scuba skills so you can become more comfortable in the water. This is a great way to get more dives under your belt while continuing to learn under the supervision of your PADI instructor. This course builds on what you've learned and develops new capabilities by introducing you to new activities and new ways to have fun scuba diving.

- > 1 Underwater navigation
- > 1 deeper water diving (typically anywhere from 18–30 meters/ 60–100 feet)

GENERAL REMARKS

- 1/ Rates based on taxes currently in application. In case of modification of these taxes, all rates will be revised accordingly.
- 2/ Regular dives : unless mentioned differently, guaranteed departure with a minimum of 2 divers
- 3/ Very important :
 - a) Divers must present their Diving Card to dive centers before diving.
 - b) For security reasons, Divers must not dive 12h prior domestic flight & 24h prior to international flight.
 - c) It is not advisable to dive more than 2 times in one day.
- 4/ Age minimum : 8 years old. For Children not travelling with their parents, parental authorization will be requested.
- 5/ Inter-islands flights : Special Luggage extra allowance of 5 kg on ATR flights, for Certified Divers how want to bring their own equipment. Divers must fly on Air Tahiti within 07 days after international arrival and present their Diving Card & International Flight tickets upon Check-In. However, you may trust the quality of the equipment available in the different dive centers ; the equipment being renewed & checked regularly according to international standards.
- 6/ Cancellation policy : dives are non refundable when cancelled within 7 days prior to dive date.
- 7/ Please revert to the separate "Diving Tips" document for all details/information about diving in French Polynesia.
